

NORTH SOMERSET LEVELS BREEDING BIRD SURVEY Spring 2026

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Methodology

This set of surveys has been conducted since 1995 with only 2001 omitted owing to foot and mouth disease restrictions.

There have been some necessary changes to the survey areas in recent years. Weston Old Airfield, Area 9, was first surveyed in 2021 but in 2024 and 2025 it was not possible to conduct the surveys because of ongoing housing development, two surveys were conducted this year. In 2023 Area 4 was split into 4A (Nailsea Moor) and 4B (Clevedon Moor) and in 2024 Area 3 was split into 3A (Kenn Moor Central) and 3B (Kenn Moor South East). These changes aim to bring the survey periods to under 2 hours as recommended by the BTO.

Each route is walked twice during the season. Ideally, in late April and then again in early June, but to some extent the survey dates are dependent on the availability of the volunteer observers. All the survey walks are carried out in the morning so bird species that are active late in the evening and at night are unlikely to be observed.

All birds that are heard during the survey period are counted, whether or not they are seen. The count of 'singing' birds is included in the total count for all the birds observed. The counts are further split into birds observed nearby, within 25m of the survey route, and those that are more distant than this.

2026 Comments

The weather this Spring was mixed but generally most species seem to have enjoyed a successful breeding season; Blackcaps are still singing as I write this in early July.

Mallards were recorded in slightly better numbers this year continuing a gradual trend of slow increase. This, along with high number of Moorhen sightings, bodes well and suggests a lack of or a very low Mink population. For the second year no Lapwing was recorded after many years of decline. Blue and Great Tits along with Robins and Wrens all did very well.

Cetti's Warblers continue to increase rapidly, there were 11 records ten years ago but 54 this year, perhaps to the detriment of Sedge Warblers whose preferred habitat the Cetti's have 'invaded'. Following a below average year for Whitethroats last year, 2026 was their best year for a very long time with reports of high numbers from many areas of the country. There were fewer records of Lesser Whitethroats than their Common Whitethroat relatives, but this species is often quiet and elusive.

Chaffinches and Greenfinches were recorded in lower numbers after a good recovery from trichomoniasis and after years of increase Goldfinches continued their recent downward trend. Sadly, for the second consecutive year, no Bullfinch was recorded, perhaps trichomoniasis is now affecting this species. However, Linnets showed well, maybe some birds from the large winter flocks have stayed to nest.

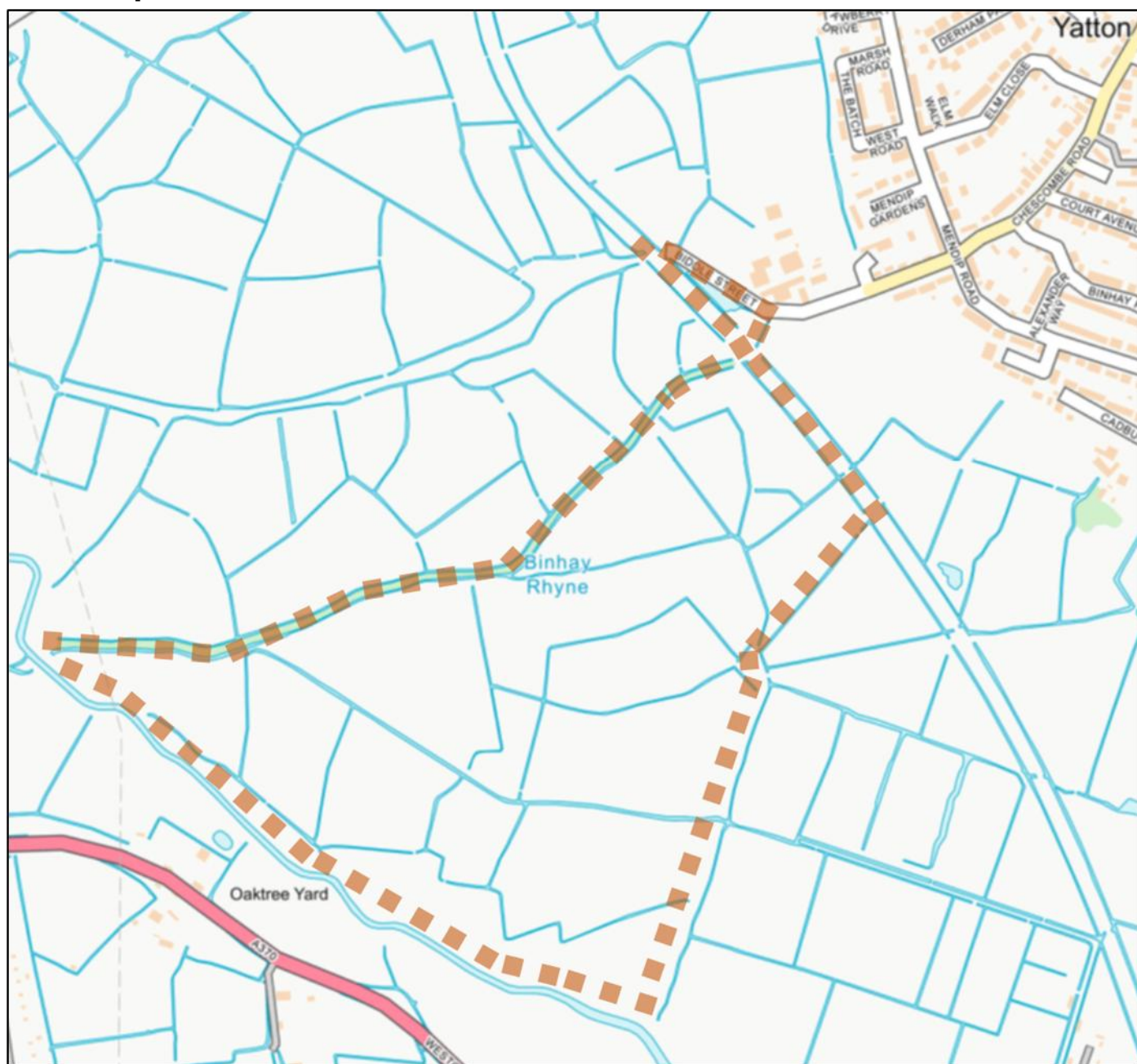

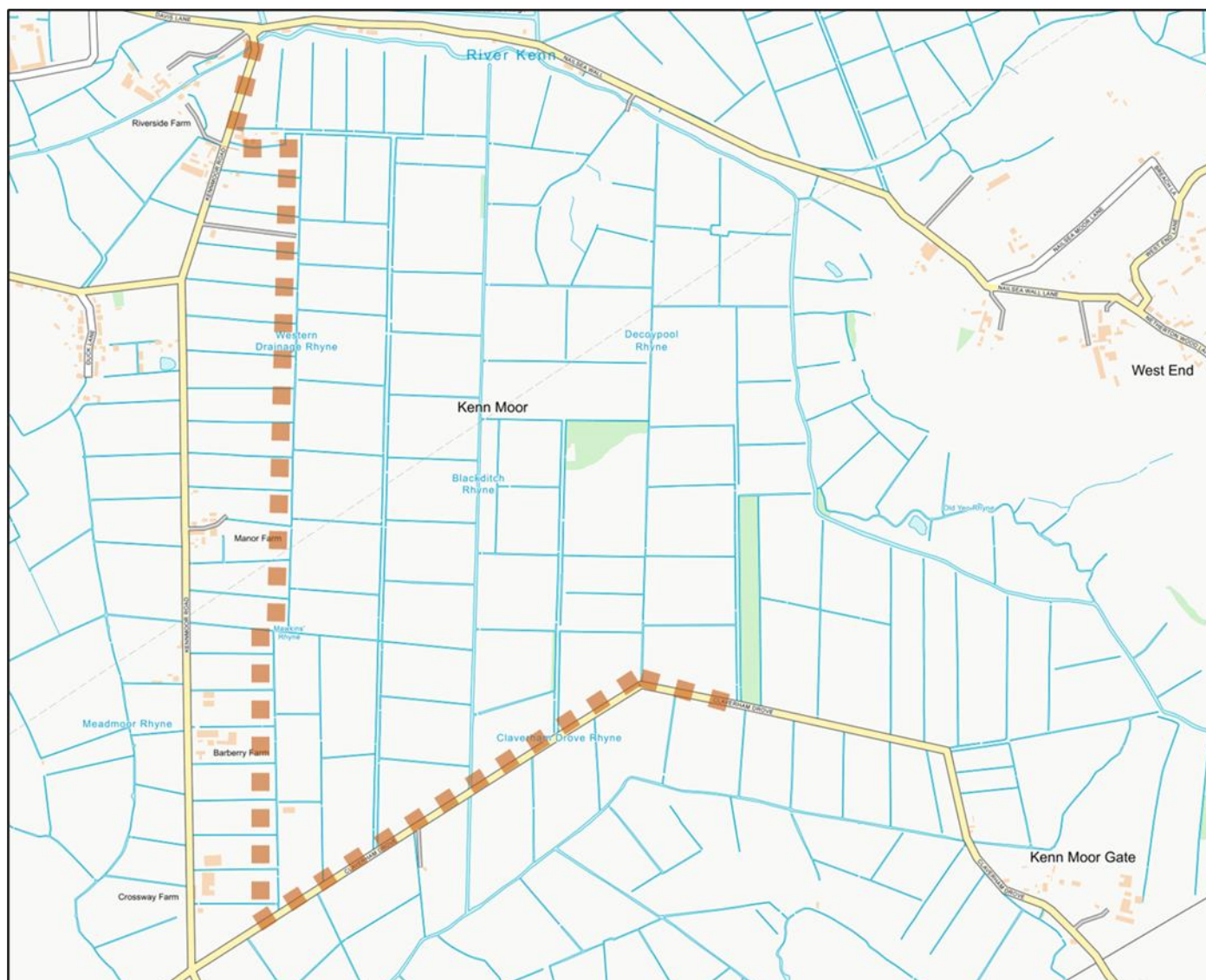

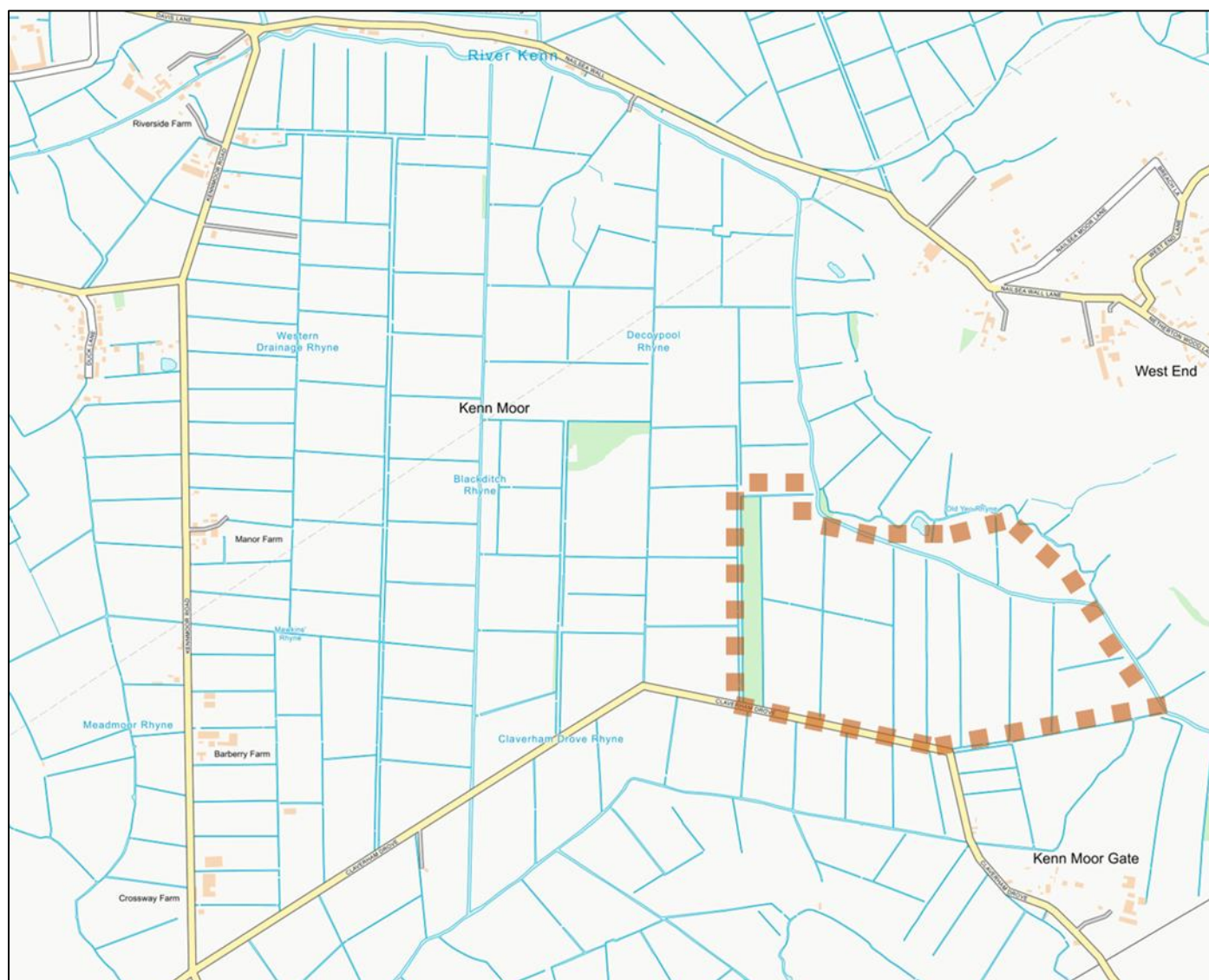

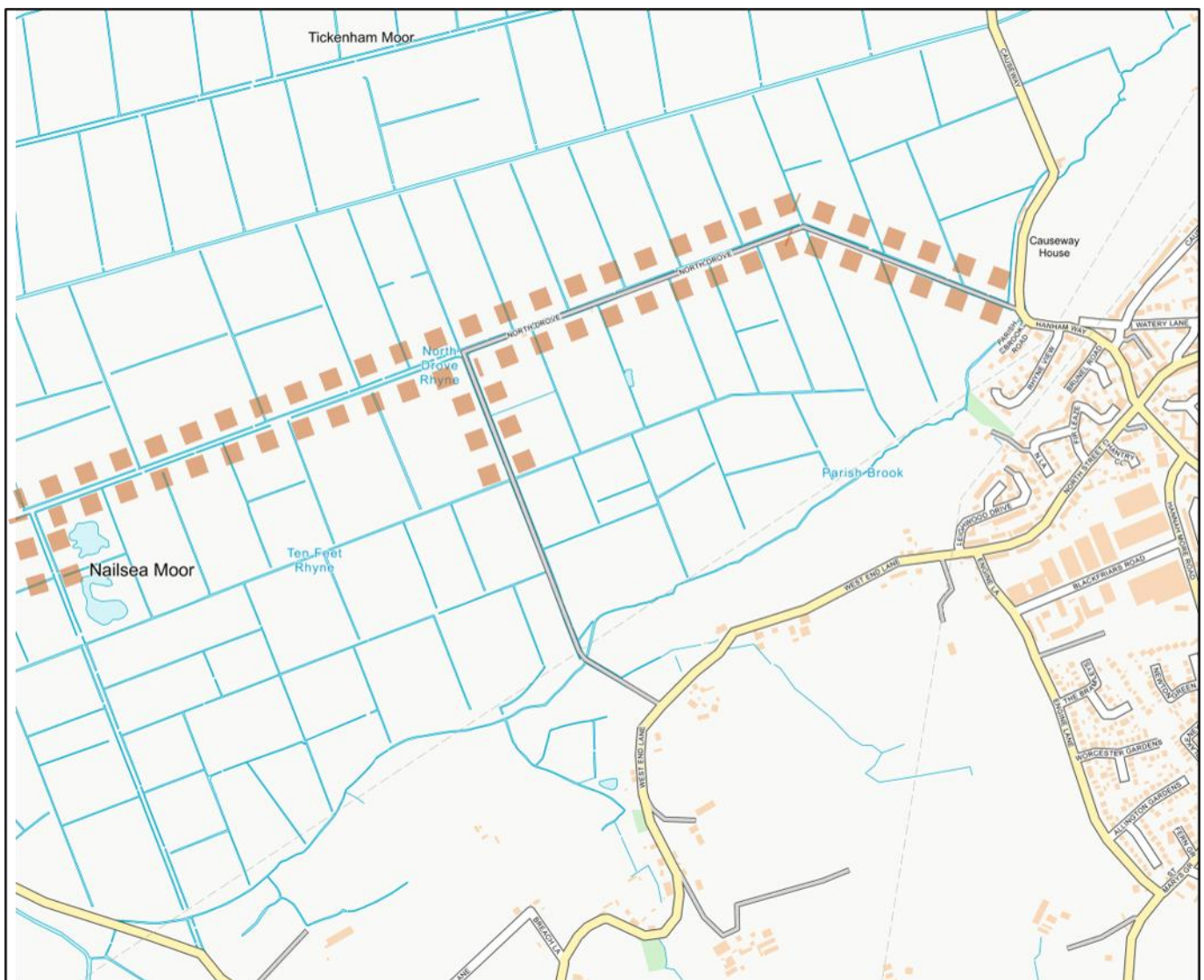

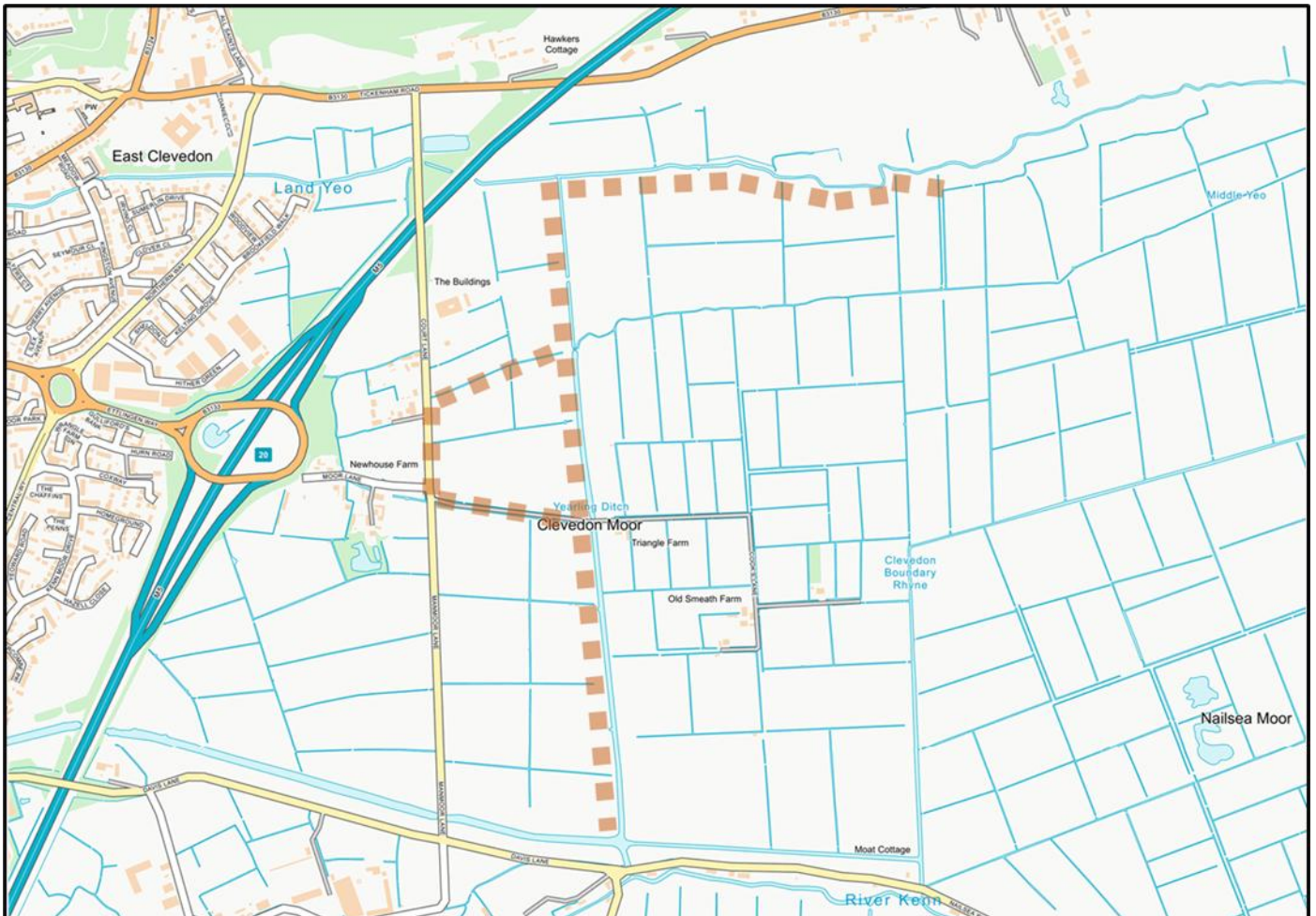

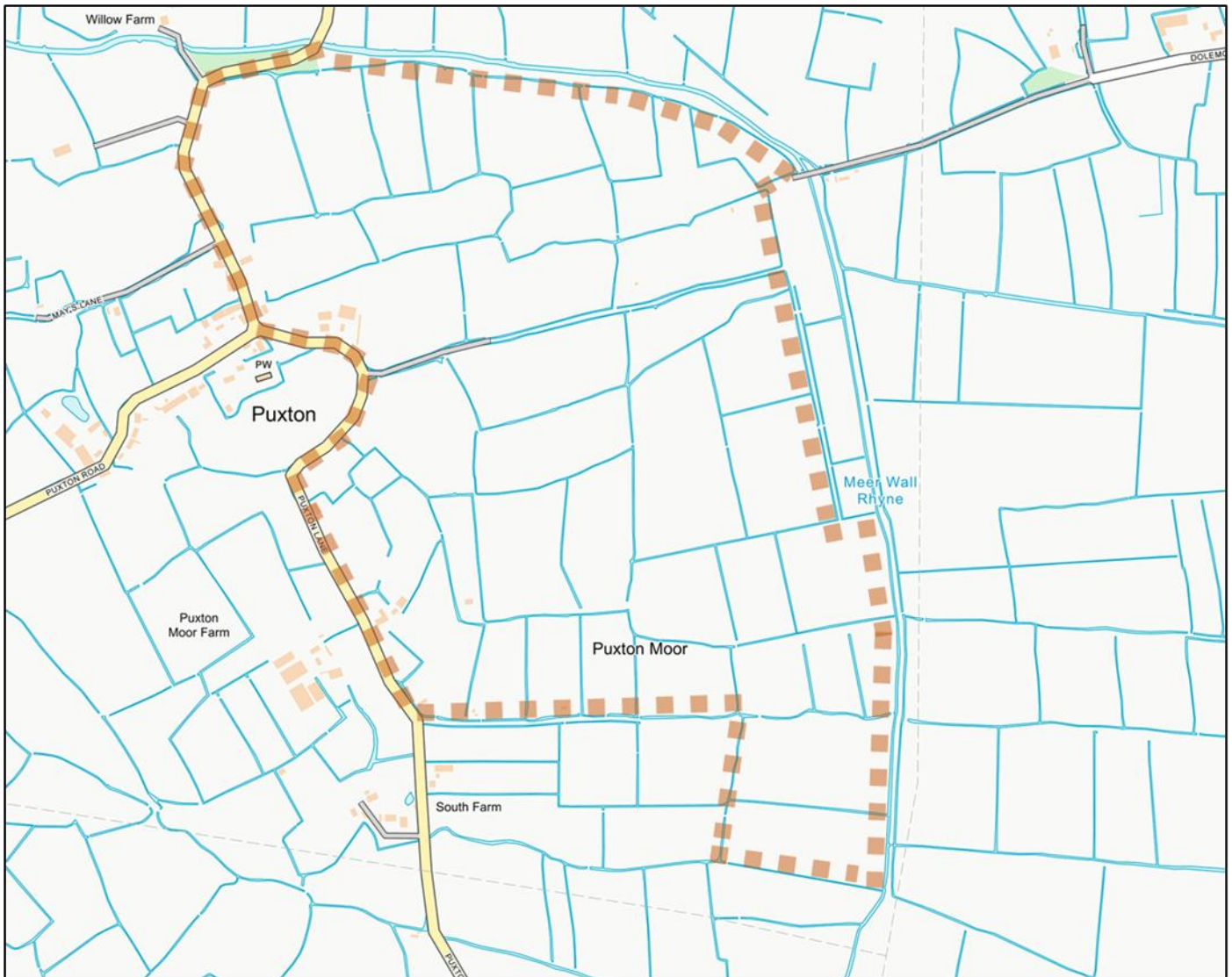

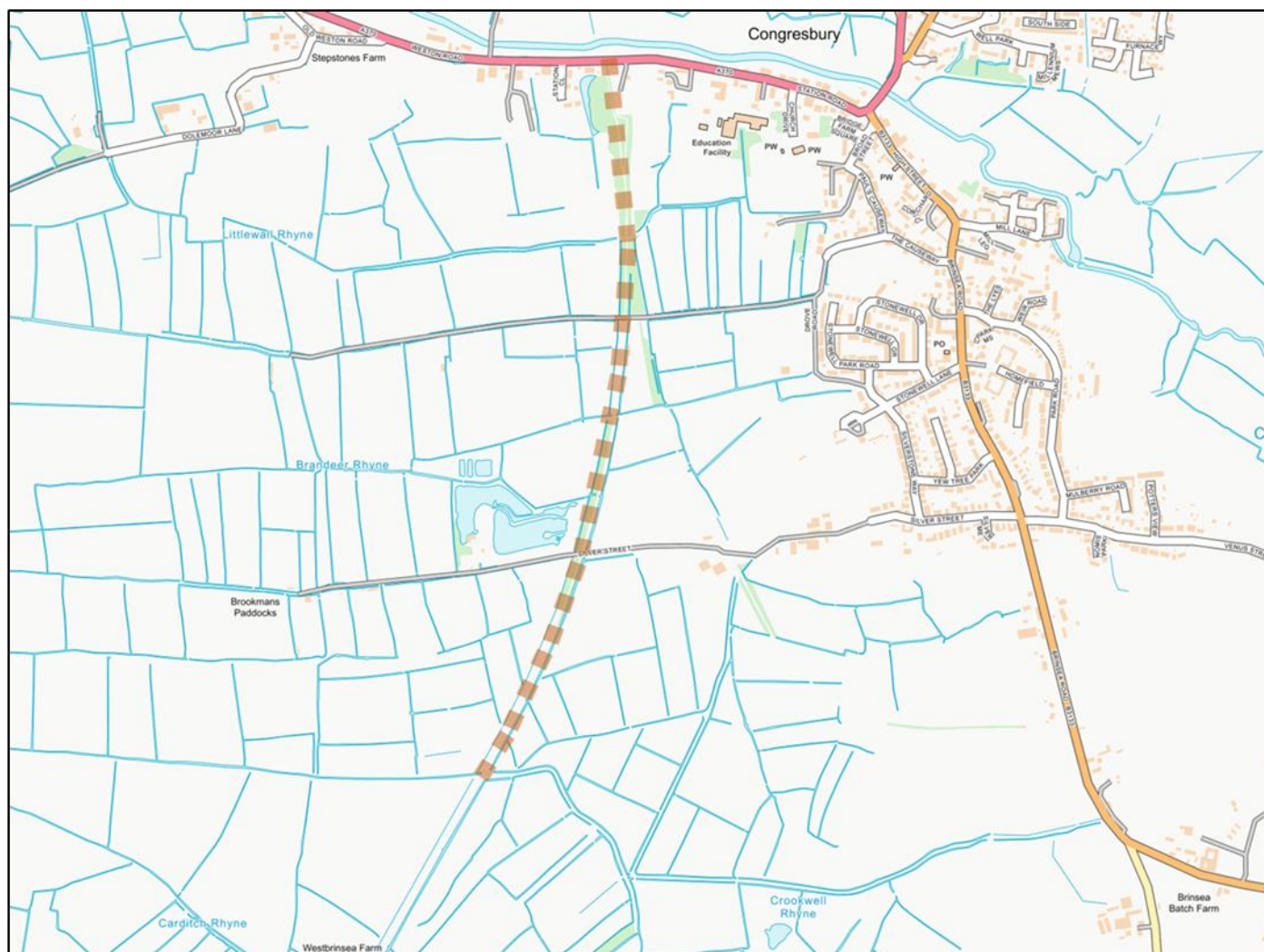
